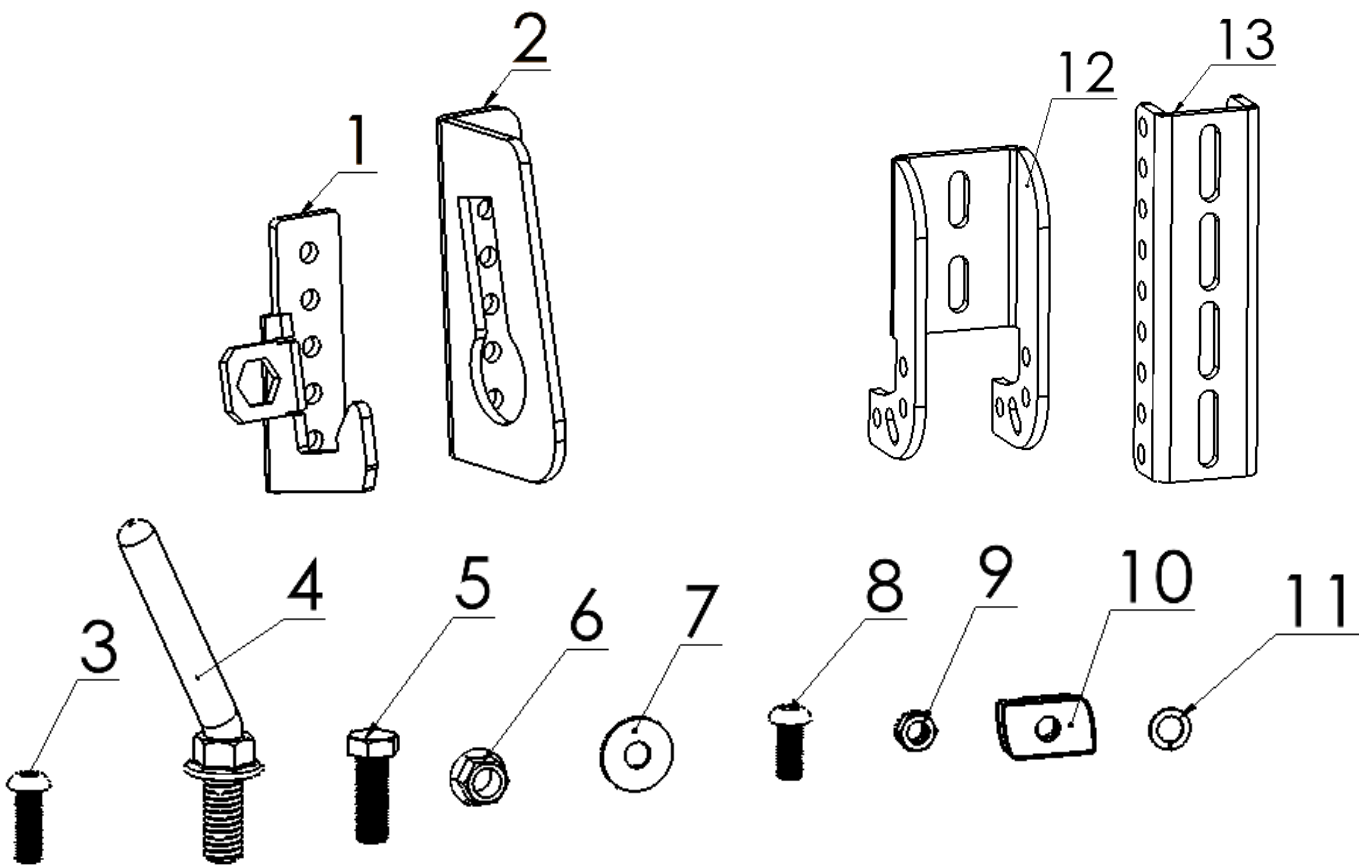

Assemble the Awning Bracket

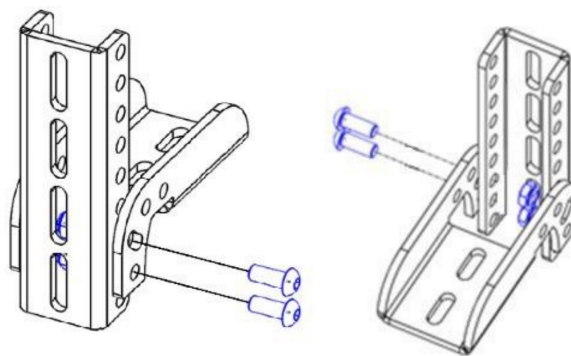
1

- Choose the desired angle for the awning bracket and align the holes

- Use the M8 bolt provided to assemble and tighten with M8 Nyloc Nut.

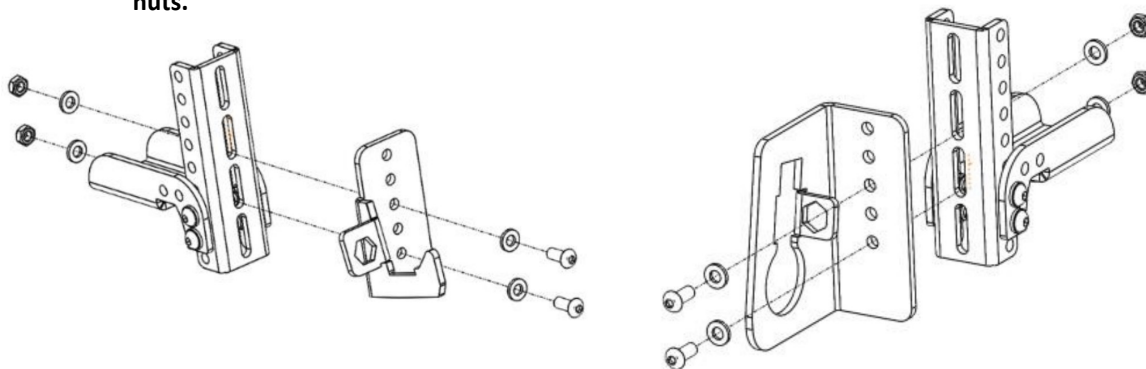

Assemble the jack holder to Awning Bracket

- Fasten the two Jack Brackets to the adjustable brackets provided using M8 bolts, washers and nuts.



Assemble the bracket to roof rack

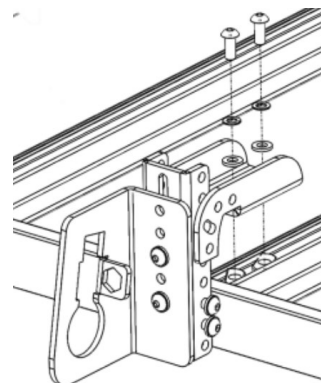
- Mount awning bracket to WT platform as shown using M8 Bolts and channel nuts provided. Do not fully tighten.

NOTE-Ensure the channel nuts are 90 degrees to the channels.



Check fastenings are firmly tensioned at regular intervals.

Do not overtighten, this will preserve the spring washers.

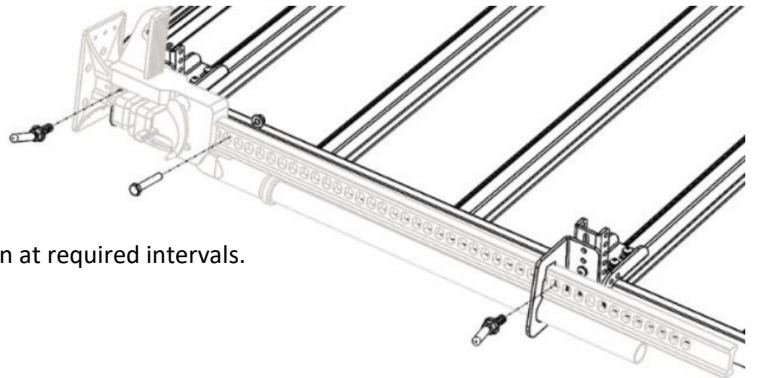
- Secure the Jack using the securing knobs provided.

- Fasten a M10 nut as shown to make sure the handle does not move.



Note: When travelling check for tension at required intervals.
