• Place the Light bar support plate on the Wedgetail platform when it is upside down.

Assemble the M8 bolt & washer and the channel nuts.






• Assemble the wind deflector and support plate to front bar using M8 bolt and nuts provided.

Once in the correct position tighten fasteners securely, check at frequent intervals

NOTE-Ensure the channel nuts are 90 degrees to the channels.




Check fastenings are firmly tensioned at regular intervals.

Do not overtighten, this will preserve the spring washers.

Wiring in perimeter Wedgetail extrusion



Holes can be drilled on the inside section of the perimeter extrusion to cater for lightbar wiring etc. Wiring gromets should be used to avoid water ingress. However, holes should not be drilled through the wedge lock connection or the area where it is fastened, or the structural strength of the roof rack will be compromised.
